Part of the events are planned to happen in partnership with two local schools in the villages of Gerdec and Marqinet areas touched by the explosion of 15 March 2008. Some of you might remember our ministry with them last year for 3 months. We continued again the work this year and the show on June 1st would be publicly presenting the work of several months. The children will be interpreting poems, songs and dancing. Some of the children will express their talent in poems and songs targeting the Children Rights.

The event will target children, as well as their teachers and parents.

The explosion deeply affected their lives and they are facing hard post trauma symptoms. We hope and pray that these activities will help children to see life with optimism and find hope and security for their future in the Lord.

Antela and Edi our very gifted staff wrote a new song on children's Rights that will be played on many secular media's on June 1st, with the main focus on the responsibility of adults to pass on the right values in the next generation. We are so thankful to the Lord for giving us such wonderful people as part of our staff and are enjoying the privilege of being part of the body of Christ.

Pray for a recent conflict occurred in Puka, a northern city in Albania between the Catholic leader of that area and some Christian workers who were distributing humanitarian help to the community. The Catholic Archbishop wrote a magazine article where he pretends that "his territory has been invaded". The Albanian Evangelical Alliance is investigating this at an institutional level. We will keep you posted as more information comes.
